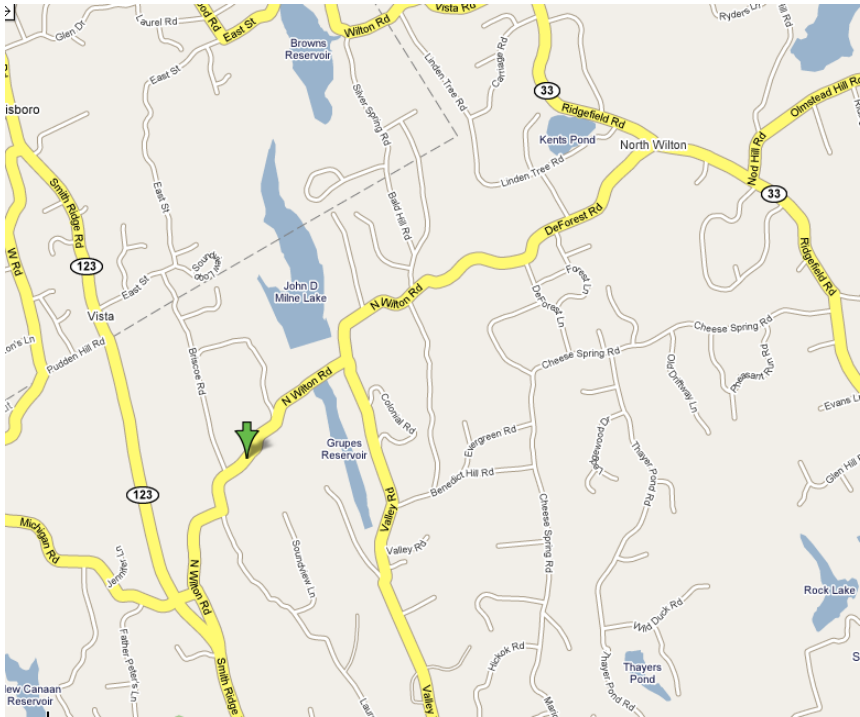


How to get to St Luke's



From the Merritt

Take Exit 38, Rte 123 north from the Merritt (Rte 15) or from Exit 1 off the Route 7 Connector.

As you drive north from the Merritt, you will pass 3 traffic lights

- Lakeview 1.2 mi
- Rte 106 1.7 mi
- Brushy Ridge 2.1 mi

You will pass a deer crossing sign at 3.6 miles.

North Wilton Rd splits off Rte 123 to the right at 4.4 miles

Follow N. Wilton Rd, staying with the main road with the double yellow line for 0.6 miles (total 5.1 miles) to a stop sign where the road ends in a "T."

There will be a sign on the right side of the T for Laurel Rd. Turn left at the T. St Luke's will be 0.3 miles more on the right hand side.

If you miss the fork onto N Wilton Rd and go on into NY State you can turn on East St by the Family Tree Garden Center. Go 0.2 miles and then turn right on Briscoe Rd. Follow Briscoe 1.1 miles until it ends at a "T" and turn left. St. Luke's is about 300 ft on the right.

From I-95

Exit 15, Norwalk, Danbury (Route 7). Follow to Route 7 connector. Stay on connector until exit for the Merritt, Route 15 South (Exit 3). Take Route 15 South to exit 38. Follow directions above.

From Danbury Area

Take route 7 to split at Route 35. Follow Rte 33 South to Deforest Rd in Wilton and proceed as below.

From Wilton Area

Take Deforest Rd from Route 33 and follow it into New Canaan, where the name changes to N Wilton Rd. Pass the reservoir and dam and climb the hill. St Luke's is on the left.
